

# Presentation of the European Solidarity Manifesto

## Summary

**a/simmetrie** and **Link Campus University** are organising a workshop on the **European Solidarity Manifesto**, that will take place on September 23, from 14:30 to 18:30, in the Francesco Cossiga and Guido De Marco Library of Link Campus University (via Nomentana 335, Rome). The aim of workshop is to provide an opportunity to discuss an alternative strategy to solve the Eurozone crisis, and to analyse the scenarios brought about by the results of the German political elections.
